## Capabilities

With the Avaya 3810 wireless telephone, you can get multi-line access, put calls on hold, see incoming Caller ID, set up conference calls and check messages while away from your desk. The 3810 wireless delivers much of the functionality of a regular, wired desk phone, including:

- 2-line, 32-character handset with liquid crystal display (LCD)
- 4 displayed operation modes indicating Talk, Ringer On/Off, Battery Low, and Message Waiting
- 4 fixed features keys: Hold, Transfer, Conference, and Redial
- 4 programmable keys to access features on the PBX
- 5 channels, supporting up to 5 simultaneous conversations
- Headset jack for hands-free mobility
- Ringer and handset volume control
- Selectable ring type
- Vibrate alert
